



AN ACT to authorize and empower the county court of Grant county to lease a certain parcel of land owned by said county, the same being known as the Hyre farm.


*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*


Section 1. *County Court of Grant County Authorized to Lease Certain County-owned Property.*—The county court of Grant county is hereby authorized and empowered to lease for a term of years a certain tract of real property owned by said county, consisting of two hundred fifty acres, more or less, situate in Milroy district of said county, and known as the Hyre farm, the same being the property conveyed to said county court by Samuel L. Hyre and Vergia B. Hyre, his wife, by deed dated January second, one thousand nine hundred forty-five, of record in the office of the county clerk of Grant county

14 This property may be leased for industrial or such other  
15 purposes as the county court may deem advisable. Any  
16 rentals derived from this property shall be credited to  
17 the general county fund of the county.


