

AN ACT to amend and reenact chapter one hundred forty-eight, acts of the Legislature, regular session, one thousand nine hundred thirty-seven, authorizing the county court of Kanawha county to expend funds for the construction and maintenance of the Four-H camp in Kanawha county.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. *Kanawha County Court Authorized to Ex-*
2 *pend Funds for Four-H Camp.*—The county court of Kana-
3 wha county may expend annually from the general county
4 fund a sum not to exceed twenty-five thousand dollars for
5 the construction and maintenance of the Kanawha County
6 Four-H camp.



Chairman Senate Committee






