AN ACT to amend and reenact section eight-a, article five, chapter twenty-eight of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to the manufacturing and securing of license plates and road signs or markers.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section eight-a, article five, chapter twenty-eight of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 8-a. *Manufacture of License Plates.*—For the
2 purpose of obtaining license plates to be used upon motor
3 vehicles licensed for operation in this state and road

4 signs or markers of any description for state roads, the
5 West Virginia commissioner of public institutions is
6 hereby authorized and empowered on behalf of the state,
7 to establish and operate a plant for the manufacture of
8 such license plates and road signs or markers at the West
9 Virginia penitentiary at Moundsville, West Virginia.

10 It shall be unlawful for any state official or employee
11 to manufacture or obtain such license plates, road signs
12 or markers otherwise than as herein specified: *Provided,*
13 *however,* That the state road commissioner may originally
14 secure road signs or markers from sources other than that
15 provided herein, when it is necessary in order to secure re-
16 imbursement from the United States against the cost
17 thereof or against the cost of installation and erection
18 thereof or against the cost of the project upon which the
19 road signs or markers have been installed or are to be in-
20 stalled, in accordance with the regulations of the bureau
21 of public roads of the United States department of com-
22 merce.
