AN ACT to amend and reenact section fourteen, article two, chapter fifty-nine of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, relating to taxation of statute fees in civil actions.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section fourteen, article two, chapter fifty-nine of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 14. Taxation of Statute Fees.—He shall include

2 in the costs to the prevailing party:

3 (a) In any civil action, ten dollars;

4 (b) To the party prevailing in the supreme court of5 appeals, thirty dollars;

6 (c) In civil actions in any court of limited jurisdiction,7 the same fees as are allowed in a circuit court for like8 actions.




