

AN ACT to authorize the county courts of Berkeley county
and Jefferson county to expend funds out of the general
fund for the construction of improvements and maintenance
of Camp Frame, 4-H Club Camp.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. *Berkeley County Court and Jefferson County*
Court Authorized to Expend from General Funds for
Construction of Improvements and Maintenance of Camp
Frame 4-H Club Camp.—The county court of Berkeley
county and the county court of Jefferson county are here-
by each authorized and empowered to expend funds in
an amount not to exceed ten thousand dollars out of the
county general fund for the construction of improvements
and maintenance of Camp Frame, 4-H Club Camp.


