**House Bill No. 401**

(By MR. WHITE)

[Passed March 11, 1961; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to amend article two, chapter fifteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, designated section seven-a, relating to leave time for members of the department of public safety called to active or inactive duty in the national guard or armed forces of the United States.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That article two, chapter fifteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section, designated section seven-a, to read as follows:

Section 7-a. *Leave Time for Members Called to Duty*  
2 *in National Guard or Reserve Component of Armed*  
3 *Forces.*—Any member of the department of public safety  
4 who is called to perform active duty for training or in-

5 active duty training in the national guard or any reserve  
6 component of the armed forces of the United States an-  
7 nually shall be granted upon request leave time not to  
8 exceed thirty days for the purpose of performing such  
9 active duty for training or inactive duty training, and  
10 the time so granted shall not be deducted from any leave  
11 accumulated as a member of the department.
