AN ACT to amend article two, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, designated section thirteen-d; and to repeal article four, chapter twenty-six of said code, all relating to the home for aged and infirm colored men and women and the real property used for such purpose.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That article two, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section, designated section thirteen-d; and that article four, chapter twenty-six of said code be repealed, to read as follows:

Section 13-d. *Transfer of Property for the Use of*

2 *Marshall University*.—On and after the first day of July,  
3 one thousand nine hundred sixty-one, supervision and  
4 control of all of the real property, heretofore administered  
5 by the commissioner of public institutions containing one  
6 hundred eighty-four and one-half acres, more or less,  
7 located in Guyandotte district, Cabell county, and known  
8 as the “West Virginia home for aged and infirm colored  
9 men and women” shall be transferred to the supervision  
10 and control of the state board of education. The state  
11 board of education shall be authorized to use the property  
12 for any purpose it may deem advisable in connection with  
13 the educational program of Marshall university.
