

[Passed March 11, 1861; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section <sup>three, article two,</sup> ~~two, article one, chapter~~  
chapter one of the code of West Virginia, one thousand  
nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to congress-  
sional districts.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That section three, article two, chapter one of the code of  
West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as  
amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 3. *Congressional Districts.*—The number of  
2 members to which the state is entitled in the house of  
3 representatives of the Congress of the United States shall  
4 be apportioned among the several counties of the state,  
5 arranged into five congressional districts, numbered as  
6 follows, that is to say:

7 First District: Braxton, Brooke, Calhoun, Doddridge,

8 Gilmer, Hancock, Harrison, Lewis, Marion, Marshall, Ohio,

9 Taylor and Wetzel.

10 Second District: Barbour, Berkeley, Grant, Greenbri-

11 er, Hampshire, Hardy, Jefferson, Mineral, Monongalia,

12 Morgan, Pendleton, Pocahontas, Preston, Randolph,

13 Tucker, Upshur, and Webster.

14 Third District: Boone, Clay, Kanawha, Nicholas and

15 Raleigh.

16 Fourth District: Cabell, Jackson, Lincoln, Logan, Mason,

17 Pleasants, Putnam, Ritchie, Roane, Tyler, Wayne, Wirt

18 and Wood.

19 Fifth District: Fayette, Mercer, Mingo, Monroe, Mc-

20 Dowell, Summers and Wyoming.
