(By MR. SPEAKER, MR. SINGLETON, and MR. SEIBERT)

[Passed March 9, 1961; in effect July 1, 1961.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section three, article five, chapter twelve of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to the examination and listing of securities in the custody of the state treasurer.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section three, article five, chapter twelve of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 3. *Legislative Auditor to Examine and List Securities.*—The legislative auditor annually shall, examine and list all of the securities in the custody of the state treasurer. A copy of the list so examined and certified shall be transmitted to the state treasurer and the department of finance and administration.
