House Bill No. 81

(By MR. BEDELL)

[Passed March 11, 1961; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section two, article fourteen-a, chapter eleven of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to the definition of gasoline.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section two, article fourteen-a, chapter eleven of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 2. *Definitions.*—The following words, terms and phrases, when used in this article, shall have the meaning ascribed to them by this section, except where the context clearly indicates a different meaning:

“Motor Carrier” means every person, firm or corporation who operates or causes to be operated on any highway in this state any passenger vehicle that has seats for

8 more than nine passengers in addition to the driver, or
9 any road tractor, or any tractor truck, or any truck hav-
10 ing more than two axles.

11 "Operations" means operations of all such vehicles,
12 whether loaded or empty, whether for compensation or
13 not for compensation, and whether owned by or leased to
14 the motor carrier who operates them or causes them to
15 be operated.

16 "Gasoline" shall include any substance or combination
17 of substances which is capable of use as a motor fuel for
18 any internal combustion engine, except fuel oil, kerosene,
19 cleaner's solvent, and any other liquid petroleum product
20 not commonly used as a motor fuel, when not used or
21 sold for use as a motor fuel in an internal combustion
22 engine.

23 "Commissioner" means the state tax commissioner of
24 West Virginia.
