AN ACT to amend article four, chapter eight of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, by adding thereto a new section designated section ten-i, relating to special school zone police officers.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That article four, chapter eight of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section designated section ten-i, to read as follows:

Section 10-i. *Special School Zone Police Officers.*—Au-  
2 thority and power is hereby conferred upon any incor-  
3 porated city or town in this state to provide by ordinance

4 for the appointment of special school zone police officers,  
5 who shall have the duty of controlling and directing traf-  
6 fic upon designated parts of streets or roads at or near  
7 schools, and who, in the performance of such duty, shall  
8 be vested with all the powers of local police officers. Such  
9 special police shall be in uniform, shall display a badge or  
10 other sign of authority, shall serve at the will and pleasure  
11 of the appointing authority, and shall not come within the  
12 civil service provisions of article five-A of this chapter or  
13 of the pension or relief fund provisions of article six of  
14 this chapter, and section eleven, article four, chapter  
15 eight-A of the official code, as amended. The council may  
16 require such special police officers to give bond, payable  
17 to the city or town, in its corporate name, with such sure-  
18 ties and in such penalty as the council may see fit, con-  
19 ditioned for the faithful performance of their duties.
