AN ACT to amend and reenact section one, article thirteen, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to the continuation and management of West Virginia state college.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section one, article thirteen, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Article 13. West Virginia State College.

Section 1. *Continuation and Management.*—The institution for the instruction of students heretofore established and located at Institute, in Kanawha county, shall

4 be continued and shall be known as the "West Virginia
5 State College." The business and educational affairs of
6 said college shall be under the control, supervision and
7 management of the state board of education, as provided
8 in section thirteen, article two of this chapter.

9 The state board of education shall establish and main-
10 tain in the West Virginia state college, in addition to the
11 courses of study leading to a bachelor of science or bach-
12 elor of arts degree, such professional and pre-professional
13 courses of study as may be expedient and practicable, and
14 shall prescribe the conditions for graduation therefrom
15 and make rules for the conferring of degrees and for is-
16 suing the proper diplomas to those who successfully com-
17 plete such courses.

18 The rules and regulations made by the president and
19 faculty of said college for its general government, for the
20 admission of students thereto, the standards of scholar-
21 ship to be maintained therein and the graduation of stu-
22 dents therefrom, shall be submitted to the state board of
23 education for its approval.
