

COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR

House Bill No. 167

(Originating in the Committee on Finance.)

[Passed March 8, 1961; in effect July 1, 1961.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section four, article three, chapter seventeen-a of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to motor and other vehicles and including among other things motor vehicle administration, registration, certificates of title and the fees and taxes imposed in connection therewith.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

S 100 8

That section four, article three, chapter seventeen-a of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 4. Application for Certificate of Title; Tax.— 2 Certificates of registration of any vehicle or registration 3 plates therefor, whether original issues or duplicates, shall 4 not be issued or furnished by the department of motor Enr. Com. Sub. for H.B. No. 167] 2

5 vehicles or any other officer charged with such duty, un-6 less the applicant therefor already has received, or shall at the same time make application for and be granted, 7 8 an official certificate of title of such vehicle. Such application shall be upon a blank form to be furnished by the 9 department of motor vehicles and shall contain a full 10 11 description of the vehicle, which description shall contain the manufacturer's serial or identification number or 12 other number as determined by the commissioner and any 13 14 distinguishing marks, together with a statement of the applicant's title and of any liens or encumbrances upon 15 such vehicle, the names and addresses of the holders of 16 17 such liens and such other information as the department of motor vehicles may require. The application shall be 18 signed and sworn to by the applicant. A tax is hereby 19 imposed upon the privilege of affecting the certification 20 of title of each vehicle in the amount equal to three per 21 cent of the value of said motor vehicle at the time of such 22 certification. If the vehicle is new, the actual purchase 23 price or consideration to the purchaser thereof shall be 24 the value of said vehicle; if the vehicle is a used or 25

26 second-hand vehicle, the present market value at time of transfer or purchase shall be deemed the value thereof 27 for the purpose of this section: Provided, however, That 28 29 if said motor vehicle is purchased in the state of West Virginia, so much of the purchase price or consideration 30 31 as is represented by the exchange of other vehicles on 32 which the tax herein imposed has been paid by the purchaser shall be deducted from the total actual price or 33 34 consideration paid for said vehicle, whether the same be 35 new or second-hand; if the vehicle be acquired through gift, or by any manner whatsoever, unless specifically 36 exempted in this section, the present market value of the 37 vehicle at the time of the gift or transfer shall be deemed 38 39 the value thereof for purposes of this section. No certificate of title for any vehicle shall be issued to any appli-40 41 cant unless such applicant shall have paid to the depart-42 ment of motor vehicles the tax imposed by this section 43 which shall be three per cent of the true and actual value of said vehicle whether the vehicle be acquired through 44 purchase, by gift, or by any other manner whatsoever 45 46 except gifts between husband and wife or between parEnr. 47 ents and children; but the tax imposed by this section 48 shall not apply to vehicles to be registered as Class H 49 or Class I vehicles, as defined in section one, article ten 50 of this chapter, which are used or to be used in interstate 51 commerce, nor shall the tax imposed by this section apply to titling of vehicles by a registered dealer of this state 52 for resale only, nor shall the tax imposed by this section 53 54 apply to titling of vehicles by this state or any political subdivision thereof, or by any volunteer fire department 55 organized and incorporated under the laws of the state of 56 57 West Virginia for protection of life or property. The total 58 amount of revenue collected by reason of this tax shall 59 be paid into the state road fund and expended by the 60 state road commissioner for matching federal aid funds allocated for West Virginia. In addition to said tax, there 61 shall be a charge of one dollar for each original certificate 62 of title so issued: Provided, That this state or any political 63 subdivision thereof, or any such volunteer fire depart-64 65 ment, shall be exempted from payment of such charge. 66 Notwithstanding the provisions of this section, the owners of trailers, semi-trailers and other vehicles not sub-67

68 ject to the certificate of title tax prior to enactment of 69 this chapter shall not be required to pay the abovemen-70 tioned tax upon making application for a certificate of 71 title for such vehicle, but shall be required to pay a fee 72 of one dollar for the issuance of each such certificate of 73 title.

Such certificate shall be good for the life of the vehicle, so long as the same is owned or held by the original holder of such certificate, and need not be renewed annually, or any other time, except as herein provided.

If, by will or direct inheritance, a person becomes the
owner of a motor vehicle upon which the tax herein imposed has been paid, he shall not be required to pay such
tax.

82 A person who has paid the tax imposed by this section shall not be required to pay the tax a second time for 83 the same motor vehicle, but he shall be required to pay a 84 85 charge of one dollar for the certificate of retitle of that motor vehicle, except that such tax shall be paid by such 86 87 person when the title to such vehicle has been transferred either in this or another state from such person to an-88 other person and transferred back to such person. 89
