**House Bill No. 73**

(By MR. MYLES)

[Passed February 3, 1962; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section two, article six-a, chapter three of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to the last day on which a person may file an announcement of his candidacy for nomination to any office, and specifically providing that the fourteenth Saturday preceding the day fixed for the primary election shall be the last day on which a person may file an announcement of his candidacy for election to a county board of education, except for the year one thousand nine hundred sixty-two.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That section two, article six-a, chapter three of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

**Section 2. Announcement of Candidacy.**—While this

2 article is in effect, the fourteenth Saturday rather than  
3 the fifth Saturday preceding the day fixed for the primary  
4 election shall be the last day on which a person may file  
5 announcement of his candidacy for nomination to any  
6 office or for election to a county board of education: *Pro-*  
7 *vided, however,* That with respect to the announcement of  
8 candidacy for election to the county board of education  
9 in the year one thousand nine hundred sixty-two, the last  
10 date for filing shall be the thirteenth Saturday preceding  
11 the day fixed for such election. In all other respects, an  
12 announcement of candidacy shall be governed by the  
13 provisions of sections five-a and six, article four, chapter  
14 three of the code.
