[Passed February 6, 1962; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to amend article two, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, designated section thirteen-g, relating to the making, validity and effect of contracts entered into by the state board of education with licensed or certain unlicensed insurers and requiring such unlicensed insurers to become licensed but exempt from premium tax provisions of the licensing laws, and further relating to the validity and effect of contracts or policies of insurance issued thereunder to individuals for supplemental retirement benefits or for other insurance benefits for persons employed by the state board of education at institutions of higher education.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article two, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section, designated section thirteen-g, to read as follows:

Article 2. State Board of Education.

Section 13-g. Requirements for Contracting with In-2 surers; Effect Thereof.—In contracting for the group in-3 surance provided for in section thirteen-c and for the sup-4 plemental retirement benefits provided for in section 5 thirteen-f of this article, as well as for other insurance 6 benefits for any and all persons employed by it at insti-7 tutions of higher learning under its control, the state board 8 of education shall solicit proposals for the coverage sought, which proposals shall be obtained by public notice inserted at least twice in a newspaper of statewide circu-10 lation at least two weeks before the final date for submit-11 12 ting proposals. The board may also solicit proposals by sending requests by mail to prospective insurers. Upon 13 14 receipt and consideration of such proposals as may be sub-15 mitted the board shall have the authority to accept the

proposal of and contract with the insurer offering the 17 insurance program or programs determined by the board, in its judgment, to be the most desirable to the benefi-19 ciaries thereof, whether such insurer be then licensed as 20 an insurance company in this state or not: Provided. That 21 no contract shall be made effective unless and until the 22 insurance company becomes licensed as a life insurance 23 company in accordance with article three, chapter thirty-24 three of this code, as amended: Provided further, That if such insurer shall be a life insurance company organized 25 26 and operated without profit to any private shareholder 27 or individual exclusively for the purpose of aiding and 28 strengthening non-profit institutions or foundations en-29 gaged primarily in education or research, by issuing in-30 surance and annuity contracts only to or for the benefit 31 of such institutions and to individuals engaged in the service of such institutions, it shall be exempt from the 32 33 payment of premium and annuity taxes provided for by 34 sections fourteen, fourteen-a and fifteen, article three, and 35 any other pertinent premium tax sections, of chapter 36 thirty-three of this code, as amended, as to all annuity or Enr. S. B. No. 11]
