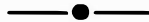

House Bill No. 135

(By MR. POLING)

[Passed March 9, 1963; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT authorizing the county court of Jackson county to
expend surplus money for development and improvement
of recreational facilities in said county.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. County Court of Jackson County May Ex-
2 pend Surplus Money for Roads and Recreational Facilities
3 in Jackson County.—The county court of Jackson county
4 may expend surplus money from the general county fund,
5 or any surplus money from any special fund available for
6 the development and improvement of recreational facili-
7 ties in Jackson county: *Provided, however,* That develop-
8 ment and improvement of such recreational facilities shall
9 be only on property owned by the county of Jackson.
