AN ACT to repeal section three-a, article five, chapter twenty-eight of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to the salary of the warden of the West Virginia penitentiary.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. Repeal of Section Regarding Salary of
2 **Warden.**—Section three-a, article five, chapter twenty-
3 eight of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine
4 hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to the salary of
5 the warden of the West Virginia penitentiary, is hereby
6 repealed.
