AN ACT to amend and reenact section three, article seven, chapter twenty-six of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to Berkeley Springs sanitarium.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section three, article seven, chapter twenty-six of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Article 7.—Berkeley Springs Sanitarium.

Section 3. Institutional Fees.—Patients shall be admitted to such institution for treatment upon payment of

3 such fees as may be established by the state commissioner
4 of public institutions, which fees shall be reasonable, but
5 patients from this state shall be allowed free treatment
6 if not pecuniarily able to pay same, under such reasonable
7 regulations as the state commissioner of public institu-
8 tions may prescribe.

9 There is hereby created a special fund which shall be
10 known as the Berkeley Springs sanitarium fund to
11 which fund shall be credited twenty-five per cent of the
12 gross receipts collected from patients, not to exceed four
13 thousand dollars. Such fund will be administered by the
14 state commissioner of public institutions and shall be used
15 for the purpose of promoting and advertising the facilities
16 available at the sanitarium.
