AN ACT to amend article four-a, chapter eight of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, designated section one-b, relating to the issuance and retiring of revenue bonds for the purpose of constructing, reconstructing and renovating any jail facility used for municipal purposes.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That article four-a, chapter eight of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section, designated section one-b, to read as follows:

**Section 1-b. Bonds for Construction and Renovation of**

**2 Municipal Jails.**—Every municipality shall have the au-  
**3** thority to issue revenue bonds for the purpose of con-  
**4** structing, reconstructing and renovating any jail facility  
**5** used for municipal prisoners; and for the purpose of  
**6** retiring such bonds, the municipality may pledge, for a  
**7** period not to exceed twenty years, the proceeds derived  
**8** from the imposition of fines and fees.
