[Passed March 2, 1963: in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to repeal article twelve-a, chapter nineteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to the West Virginia state apple commission.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. Repeal of Article Creating West Virginia
