AN ACT to amend and reenact section eleven, chapter one hundred ninety-three, acts of the Legislature, regular session, one thousand nine hundred fifty-three, fixing terms of the criminal court of McDowell county.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section eleven, chapter one hundred ninety-three, acts of the Legislature, regular session, one thousand nine hundred fifty-three, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 11. Terms of McDowell County Criminal

2 Court.—There shall be four terms of said court held in
3 each year, commencing on the Tuesday following the
4 second Monday in the months of January, April, July and
5 October. Adjourned and special terms of said court may
6 be called and held as provided for adjourned and special
7 terms of the circuit court.
