Senate Bill No. 211

(By MR. CARSON, MR. PRESIDENT, and MR. SMITH)

[Passed March 6, 1963; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section sixteen, article two, chapter seventeen-a of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to authority of department of motor vehicles to seize documents and plates.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section sixteen, article two, chapter seventeen-a of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 16. Seizure of Documents and Plates.—The department is hereby authorized to take possession of any certificate of title, registration card, permit, license, or registration plate issued by it upon expiration, revocation,

5 cancellation, or suspension thereof, or which is fictitious,
6 or which has been unlawfully or erroneously issued.

7 When the department determines that the required fee
8 for the issuance by the department of any registration
9 card, permit, license or registration plate, or the required
10 tax imposed by section four of article three of this chap-
11 ter, has not been paid and shall not be paid upon reason-
12 able notice and demand, the commissioner is authorized
13 and empowered to cancel or suspend or revoke, as he
14 shall deem appropriate, any and all registration cards,
15 permits, operator's and chauffeur's licenses, and regis-
16 tration plate or plates issued to the person, firm or cor-
17 poration by whom or on whose account any such fee or
18 tax shall have been so determined to remain unpaid
19 after such reasonable notice and demand.
