AN ACT to amend and reenact section two, article one, chapter twenty-one of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to qualifications; appointment; term of office; and salary of the commissioner of labor.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That section two, article one, chapter twenty-one of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

**Section 2. Commissioner of Labor; Qualifications; Ap-  
2 pointment; Term of Office; Salary.**—The state commis-  
3 sioner of labor shall be appointed by the governor, by and  
4 with the advice and consent of the senate. He shall be a

5 competent person, who is identified with the labor inter-  
6 ests of the state. The commissioner of labor in office on  
7 the effective date of this act shall, unless sooner removed,  
8 continue to serve until his term expires and his successor  
9 has been appointed and has qualified. On or before the  
10 first day of April, one thousand nine hundred forty-one,  
11 and on or before the first day of April of each fourth year  
12 thereafter, the governor shall appoint a commissioner of  
13 labor to serve for a term of four years, commencing on  
14 said first day of April. Notwithstanding the provisions of  
15 section two-a, article seven, chapter six of this code, the  
16 salary of the commissioner of labor shall be ten thou-  
17 sand dollars per annum.
