## ENROLLED House Bill No. 426

(By MR. WHITE)

[Passed March 9, 1963; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section four-a, article one, chapter thirty-nine of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to acknowledgment of persons in the military service of the United States of America.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section four-a, article one, chapter thirty-nine of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Article 1. Authentication and Record of Writings.

Section 4-a. Acknowledgment of Persons in the Mili-2 tary Service of the United States of America; Who May 3 Take Same, and Form Thereof.—Upon the request of any Enr. H. B. No. 426]

4 person interested therein, the clerk of the county court of 5 any county in which any deed, contract, power of attorney, or other writing is to be, or may be, recorded, shall admit 6 the same to record as to any person whose name is signed 7 thereto who is in the military service of the United 8 States (including the women's army auxiliary corps, 9 women's appointed volunteers for emergency service, 10 army nurse corps, "Spars", women's reserve, or similar 11 12 women's auxiliary unit officially connected with the mili-13 tary service of the United States) or who is the spouse 14 of anyone in the military service of the United States 15 (including the aforesaid components and auxiliary units 16 officially connected therewith), upon the certificate of 17 acknowledgment of such person before any commissioned officer of any branch of the military service of the United 18 States, or auxiliary unit officially connected with such 19 20 military service. Such acknowledgment may be taken at any place either within or outside of the United States 21 of America, or any territory, possession or dependency 22 23 thereof. The certificate of such acknowledgment need not 24 state the place where same is taken and shall require no

seal to be affixed thereto.
