[Passed January 31, 1964; in effect January 1, 1965.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section four, chapter one hundred seventy-two, acts of the Legislature, regular session, one thousand nine hundred forty-seven, as last amended by chapter one hundred eighty-two, acts of the Legislature, regular session, one thousand nine hundred fifty-seven, relating to the salary of the judge of the domestic relations court of Kanawha county.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section four, chapter one hundred seventy-two, acts of the Legislature, regular session, one thousand nine hundred

forty-seven, as last amended by chapter one hundred eighty-two, acts of the Legislature, regular session, one thousand nine hundred fifty-seven, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 4. Salary.—The judge of the domestic relations
2 court of Kanawha county, West Virginia, shall, from and
3 after the first day of January, one thousand nine hundred
4 sixty-five, receive for his services a salary in the amount
5 of fifteen thousand dollars per annum, to be paid in
6 monthly installments out of the county treasury of Ka-
7 nawha county, out of funds of said treasury, in the man-
8 ner provided by statute. The salary of said judge shall
9 continue as provided in chapter one hundred eighty-eight,
10 acts of the Legislature, regular session, one thousand nine
11 hundred fifty-five, until the first day of January, one
12 thousand nine hundred sixty-five.
