**Senate Bill No. 35**

**(By MR. McCOURT)**

[Passed February 6, 1964; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section two-e, article thirteen, chapter eleven of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to business and occupation tax on the business of contracting.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That section two-e, article thirteen, chapter eleven of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 2-e. **Business of Contracting.**—Upon every person engaging or continuing within this state in the business of contracting, the tax shall be equal to two and six-tenths per cent of the gross income of the business: *Provided*, That said tax shall be reduced to two per cent

**6 of the gross income of the business derived from contracts**  
**7 entered into on or after the first day of July, one thousand**  
**8 nine hundred sixty-five.**
