House Bill No. 530

(By MR. BLACK and MR. PAULEY, of Kanawha)

[Passed March 13, 1965; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section sixteen, article four, chapter eight of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to the regulation and licensing by municipalities of stationary engineers, plumbing contractors, plumbers, electrical contractors, electricians and other activities and trades affecting the public health and safety.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section sixteen, article four, chapter eight of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Article 4. Powers, Duties and Allied Relations of Municipal Corporations, Councils or Officers.

Section 16. Regulatory License.—Any municipality
2 governed by the provisions of this chapter may by ordi-
3 nance provide for the regulation and licensing of sta-
4 tionary engineers, plumbing contractors, plumbers, elec-
5 trical contractors, electricians and other activities and
6 trades affecting the public health and safety.
