House Bill No. 602

(By MR. HOVERMALE)

[Passed February 19, 1965; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact chapter one hundred sixty-three, acts of the Legislature, regular session, one thousand nine hundred twenty-nine, empowering the county court of Morgan county to appropriate and contribute county funds toward the support and maintenance of the "Morgan County Library," located on state property at Berkeley Springs in the county of Morgan.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That chapter one hundred sixty-three, acts of the Legislature, regular session, one thousand nine hundred twenty-nine, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 1. Morgan County Court Authorized to Con-
tribute County Funds for Support and Maintenance of
Library.—The county court of Morgan county, West Vir-
ginia, as an aid to education in said county, is hereby
authorized and empowered to appropriate and pay out of
the general county fund, a sum not to exceed one thou-
sand dollars annually toward the support and mainte-
nance of the Morgan county library, located at Berkeley
Springs in said county.
