## ENROLLED House Bill No. 657

(By Mr. Speaker, Mr. White)

[Passed March 12, 1965; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT, amend and reenact section two, article one, chapter twenty-four of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to the appointment, qualification and disqualification of members of the public service commission; the removal from office of such members; and their terms and salaries.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section two, article one, chapter twenty-four of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Article 1. General Provisions.

Section 2. Appointment, Qualification and Disquali-

fication of Commissioners; Removal from Office; Terms of Office; Salaries.—There shall be a public service commission of West Virginia which by that name may sue and be sued. The commission shall consist of three members who shall be appointed by the governor with the 7 advice and consent of the senate. The commissioners shall be citizens and residents of this state and at least one of them shall be a lawyer of not less than ten years 10 actual experience at the bar. The terms of each of said 11 commissioners in effect when this act becomes effective 12 are hereby abolished. On said date the governor shall appoint a commissioner to serve for a period of two years, 13 another commissioner to serve for a period of four years, 15 and another commissioner to serve for a period of six years. Every appointment of a commissioner thereafter 17 shall be for a period of six years, except that an appointment to fill a vacancy shall be for the unexpired term only. Each commissioner shall, before entering upon the duties of his office, take and subscribe to the oath provided by section five, article four of the constitution, which oath 22 shall be filed in the office of the secretary of state. The 23 governor shall annually designate one of the commis-

24 sioners as chairman, and may remove any commissioner

25 only for incompetency, neglect of duty, gross immortality

26 or malfeasance in office.

27 No person while in the employ of, or holding any official

28 relation to, any public utility subject to the provisions of

29 this chapter, or holding any stock or bonds thereof, or

30 who is pecuniarily interested therein, shall serve as a

31 member of the commission or as an employee thereof.

32 Nor shall any such commissioners be a candidate for

33 or hold public office, or be a member of any political com-

34 mittee, while acting as such commissioner; nor shall any

35 commissioner or employee of said commission receive

36 any pass, free transportation or other thing of value,

37 either directly or indirectly, from any public utility sub-

38 ject to the provisions of this chapter. In case any of such

39 commissioners shall become a candidate for any public

40 office or a member of any political committee, his office

41 as commissioner shall be ipso facto vacated.
