(By MR. SPEAKER, MR. WHITE)

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[Passed March 12, 1965; in effect ninety days from passage.]

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AN ACT to amend article one, chapter sixteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, designated section twenty-two, relating to the authority of the state director of health to provide for the training of certain designated employees of the state department of health.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That article one, chapter sixteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section, designated section twenty-two, to read as follows:

**Article 1. State Department of Health.**

**Section 22. Training of Employees.**—To insure adequate standards of public service, the state director of health is authorized to provide technical and specialized instruction for employees of the state department of health.

If upon review of the personnel records of any employee of the state department of health, the director is of the opinion that it would be in the best interest of the state department of health to provide any such employee with additional training or instruction, not to exceed nine months in any four-year period, in the field or vocation in which said employee is engaged, the director is authorized, upon approval of the governor, to direct that such employee obtain said additional training or instruction at such place as the director may deem suitable. Designated attendance of said employees shall be compensated for as a part of regular employment. The director is further authorized to pay out of federal funds and such state funds as are available to match such federal funds, any required tuition or enrollment fees.
