House Bill No. 827

(By MR. SPEAKER, MR. WHITE)

[Passed March 12, 1965; in effect July 1, 1965.]

AN ACT to amend article ten, chapter nine of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, designated section five-b, relating to the establishment of a joint counties fund and the administration thereof for general relief.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article ten, chapter nine of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section, designated section five-b, to read as follows:

Article 10. Fiscal Provisions

Section 5-b. Counties Joint Fund; Administration of

2 Fund; Election to Participate; Transfer of Balances in

3 County General Relief Fund.—For a more effective ad-

4 ministration of general relief, the counties of the state

5 are hereby authorized to join together in the establish-

6 ment of a joint fund. The fund shall be administered by

7 the state commissioner of welfare in the same manner

8 as the funds provided for in section seven of this article.

9 Expenditures from this fund shall be made by the state

10 commissioner of welfare without regard to county lines.

11 The county court of any county may elect to participate

12 in the joint fund in the manner and on such forms as may

13 be prescribed by the state commissioner of welfare. When

14 a county court has elected to participate in said joint fund

15 it shall not thereafter be permitted to revoke its action

16 nor to withdraw its election to participate.

17 When any county court elects to participate in the

18 joint fund it shall transfer all balances remaining in the

19 county general relief fund to the joint fund, which fund

20 is hereby established and any county court that elects to

21 participate in said joint fund is hereby authorized to make

22 a transfer of any balance remaining in said county general
23 relief fund notwithstanding any other provisions of law
24 to the contrary.

25 Any county court electing to participate in such joint
26 fund shall, in lieu of the requirements of section five of
27 this article, provide for the fiscal year 1965-66 not less
28 than nine per cent of the total the county is legally
29 authorized to levy for current purposes by section ten,
30 article eight, chapter eleven of the code of West Virginia,
31 one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended. For
32 the fiscal year one thousand nine hundred sixty-six-sixty-
33 seven and thereafter the amount so required shall be not
34 less than six per cent.


