House Bill No. 904

(By MR. SPEAKER, MR. WHITE)

[Passed March 6, 1965; in effect July 1, 1965.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact sections one, three and four, article three, chapter twenty-one-a of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, creating an advisory council in the department of employment security, fixing terms of office and prescribing qualifications for the members thereof.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That sections one, three and four, article three, chapter twenty-one-a of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Article 3. Advisory Council.

Section 1. Creation.—There is hereby created in the
2 department of employment security a “state advisory
3 council” composed of nine members.

Sec. 3. Term of Office.—The term of office of the mem-
2 bers of the council shall be six years.

3 In case of a vacancy, the governor shall make an ap-
4 pointment for the remainder of the unexpired term.

5 Members shall be subject to removal at the will and
6 pleasure of the governor.

Sec. 4. Qualifications.—The members of the council
2 shall be selected with special reference to their ability
3 and fitness to effectuate the purposes of this chapter.

4 Three members of the council shall be selected as rep-
5 resentatives of employer interests; three members shall
6 be selected as representatives of employee interests; and
7 three members shall represent the interests of the general
8 public.
