[Passed March 12, 1965; in effect July 1, 1965.]

AN ACT to authorize and empower the county court of Mingo
county to establish a Mingo county law library.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. Mingo County Law Library; Control and

2 **Management.**—There is hereby created the Mingo county
3 law library which shall be wholly under the control and
4 management of the circuit clerk of Mingo county, under
5 rules and regulations promulgated by the judge of the
6 twenty-fourth judicial circuit.

Sec. 2. Mingo County Court Authorized to Expend

2 **Funds.**—The county court of Mingo county is hereby
3 authorized to and may expend funds for the purchase of

4 books or other expense necessary to the purpose of this
5 act.

Sec. 3. Compensation of Circuit Clerk.—By reason of
2 additional duties imposed under the provisions of this act
3 the annual compensation of the circuit clerk shall on and
4 after the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred
5 sixty-five, be in the amount of seven thousand two hun-
6 dred dollars.
