(By MR. CARSON, MR. PRESIDENT, and MR. PORTER)

[Passed March 10, 1965; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to amend article three, chapter seventeen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, designated section six-b, relating to construction, reconstruction, repair and maintenance of roads by the state road commissioner and the county courts on a matching fund basis.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article three, chapter seventeen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section, designated section six-b, to read as follows:

Article 3. State Road Fund.**Section 6-b. Matching Funds With Counties For Con-**

2 **struction, Reconstruction, Repair and Maintenance of Sec-**
3 **ondary Roads, Access and Other Roads.**—When the state
4 road commissioner determines that there are funds avail-
5 able for the purpose of participating, on a matching fund
6 basis, with the county court of one or more counties for
7 the construction, reconstruction, repair and maintenance
8 of any secondary roads within said county or counties, he
9 shall in his discretion determine the amount the county
10 court must deposit or place in escrow for matching pur-
11 poses before the state road commissioner will commit any
12 funds to a proposed project.

13 Nothing in this section shall be construed to alter or
14 change in any way the allotment of funds for secondary
15 roads as provided by section six-a of this article: *Pro-*
16 *vided, however,* That the secondary road fund of the
17 county or counties participating under this section shall
18 be charged with the amount advanced by the state road
19 commissioner.
