AN ACT to amend and reenact section six, article one, chapter thirteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to the specification of purposes in the order or ordinance submitting the proposition of issuing bonds to a vote.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That section six, article one, chapter thirteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

**Section 6. Bonds May Be for More than One Purpose.—**

- 2 The order or ordinance submitting the proposition of is-  
3 suing bonds to a vote may specify more than one purpose

4 for which bonds are to be issued: *Provided*, That the  
5 amount of the proceeds of the issue to be used for each  
6 purpose shall also be specified therein: *Provided further*,  
7 That all expenditures, including but not limited to ex-  
8 penditures for the acquisition of sites, the construction,  
9 erection, equipping and furnishing of one or more build-  
10 ings, structures, improvements or facilities, or group of  
11 buildings, structures, improvements or facilities, and the  
12 relocation, alteration, renovation or enlargement of any  
13 existing buildings, structures, improvements or facilities,  
14 or group of buildings, structures, improvements or facili-  
15 ties, for the same general purpose shall be construed to be  
16 a single purpose within the meaning of this section. It  
17 shall not be necessary to specify in the order or ordinance  
18 submitting the proposition the amount of the proceeds  
19 of such bond issue to be used for each such site, building,  
20 structure, improvement or facility, or group of buildings,  
21 structures, improvements or facilities, which are a part of  
22 the same general purpose and it shall be sufficient com-  
23 pliance with this section if such order or ordinance state  
24 only the general purposes for which bonds are to be issued

25 and the amount of the proceeds of such issue to be used  
26 for each such general purpose.
