# House Bill No. 883

(Originating in the Committee on Finance)

[Passed March 12, 1965; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section eleven, article three, chapter twelve of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to traveling expenses, audit by state board and dues to voluntary organizations.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section eleven, article three, chapter twelve of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows: Enr. Com. Sub. for H. B. No. 883] 2

#### Article 3. Appropriations and Expenditures.

Section 11. Traveling Expenses; Rules to Be Promul-

- 2 gated by Board of Public Works; Dues to Voluntary Or-
- 3 ganizations; Recruitment Expenses for Institutions of
- 4 Higher Education.—The board of public works shall
- 5 promulgate rules and regulations concerning out-of-state
- 6 travel by state officials and employees. A copy of such
- 7 rules and regulations shall be filed with the auditor, and
- 8 the secretary of state. It shall be unlawful for the auditor
- 9 to issue a warrant in payment of any claim for out-of-
- 10 state travel expenses incurred by a state officer or em-
- 11 ployee unless such claim meets all the requirements of the
- 12 rules and regulations so filed.
- 13 Payment for dues or membership in annual or other
- 14 voluntary organizations shall be made from the proper
- 15 item or appropriation after an itemized schedule of such
- 16 organizations, together with the amount of such dues or
- 17 membership, has been submitted to the budget director
- 18 and approved by the board of public works.
- 19 It shall be lawful for the governing board of any state
- 20 institution of higher education to authorize the payment

- 21 of traveling expenses incurred by any person invited to
- 22 visit the campus or other facilities of such institution to be
- 23 interviewed concerning his possible employment by such
