[Passed March 12, 1965; in effect July 1, 1965.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section four, article four, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to the compensation of county superintendents.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section four, article four, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 4. Compensation.—On or before the first day of
2 May of the year in which the superintendent is appointed,
3 the board shall fix the annual salary of the superintend-
4 ent for the period of appointment for the term beginning
5 on the first day of July following. The board shall pay

6 the salary from the general current expense fund of the
7 district: *Provided*, That, beginning with the effective date
8 of this act, any newly appointed superintendent and not
9 now employed and/or serving as superintendent, shall not
10 only have met the requirements set forth in section two
11 of this article but in addition thereto shall hold at least
12 a master's degree or its equivalent obtained in an insti-
13 tution of higher education approved to offer graduate
14 work and that such work shall be related to public school
15 education.
