AN ACT to amend and reenact section four, article four, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to the compensation of county superintendents.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section four, article four, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 4. Compensation.—On or before the first day of

- 2 May of the year in which the superintendent is appointed,
- 3 the board shall fix the annual salary of the superintend-
- 4 ent for the period of appointment for the term beginning
- 5 on the first day of July following. The board shall pay

- 6 the salary from the general current expense fund of the
- 7 district: Provided, That, beginning with the effective date
- 8 of this act, any newly appointed superintendent and not
- 9 now employed and/or serving as superintendent, shall not
- 10 only have met the requirements set forth in section two
- 11 of this article but in addition thereto shall hold at least
- 12 a master's degree or its equivalent obtained in an insti-
- 13 tution of higher education approved to offer graduate
- 14 work and that such work shall be related to public school
- 15 education.
