AN ACT to amend article five, chapter seven of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, designated section nineteen, relating to payments to sheriffs, assessors and their deputies for mileage in driving their personally owned cars in the discharge of their official duties.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article five, chapter seven of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section, designated section nineteen, to read as follows:

**Section 19. Allowance for Mileage of Sheriffs, Assessors,
2 and Their Deputies.**—Notwithstanding the provisions of

3 section twelve, article seven, chapter seven, and section
4 ten, article two, chapter eleven of this code or any other
5 provisions of law to the contrary, the county court of
6 each county may allow the sheriff, assessor, and each
7 deputy of the sheriff and assessor, when engaged in the
8 discharge of his official duties, not less than seven cents
9 nor more than ten cents per mile for each mile each
10 sheriff, assessor, and each deputy of the sheriff and asses-
11 sor is required to drive his personally owned car. Each
12 sheriff and assessor shall file monthly, under oath, a full
13 and accurate account of all the actual mileage driven
14 by him and his deputies in the discharge of their official
15 duties, supported by verified accounts before payment
16 thereof shall be allowed by the county court.
