AN ACT to amend article three, chapter seventeen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, designated section one-a, to provide that the governor shall cause an annual audit to be made of the expenditures of revenue derived from the sale of road bonds issued under authority of the constitutional amendment adopted by the people in November, one thousand nine hundred sixty-four.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:


That article three, chapter seventeen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section, designated section one-a, to read as follows:

Section 1-a. Audit: Better Roads Amendment.—The
2 governor shall cause an annual audit to be made of the
3 books, accounts and records relating to the expenditures
4 for the building and construction of state roads and high-
5 ways derived from the revenue of the two hundred
6 million-dollar road bond issue, known as the “Better Roads
7 Amendment”. The state road commissioner shall make
8 available to the persons performing such audit its books,
9 accounts and records pertaining to funds expended or
10 obligated for the building and construction of state roads
11 and highways wherein such building and construction is
12 programmed from the funds made available under the
13 two hundred million-dollar road bond issue. The persons
14 performing such audit shall make available annually the
15 audit reports with copies thereof to the Legislature, the
16 state road commissioner, the secretary of state, the state

17 treasurer, the attorney general, and the state auditor; and
18 the audit report shall be available to the public, in the
19 office of the secretary of state.

20 The governor may obtain the services of a resident
21 certified public accountant or resident public accountant
22 for this purpose or may request that said audit be made
23 by the legislative auditor of the state of West Virginia, but
24 in no event shall the cost of said audit exceed the sum of
25 fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) annually, which shall
26 be payable out of the state road fund, provided no such
27 payment shall be made to the legislative auditor for serv-
28 ices rendered hereunder.


