AN ACT to authorize the county court of Jackson county to create a special fund for the Jackson county junior fair and to make expenditures therefrom.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. Jackson County Court Authorized to Create

- 2 a Special Fund for the Jackson County Junior Fair.—The
- 3 county court of Jackson county is hereby authorized
- 4 and empowered to create a special fund for the Jackson
- 5 county junior fair, and to transfer into such fund such
- 6 unexpended sums and surpluses, presently or hereafter
- 7 existing, in the county general fund or in any special
- 8 fund of the county, as the county court shall deem proper
