AN ACT authorizing and empowering the public land corporation to sell certain public land to the urban renewal authority of Wheeling.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. Public Land Corporation Authorized to

2 Sell Certain Public Land to the Urban Renewal Author-
3 ity of Wheeling.—The public land corporation is hereby
4 authorized and empowered to sell to the urban renewal
5 authority of Wheeling that part of the former state
6 capitol lands located in Wheeling, West Virginia, that is
7 occupied by the addition to “Independence Hall” which
8 addition was made circa one thousand nine hundred
9 fourteen and which is a part of what is known as the old
10 customs house property.
