Senate Bill No. 43

(By Mr. McCourt)

[Passed February 2, 1966; in effect July 1, 1966.]

AN ACT to repeal section two-a, article seventeen, chapter eleven of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, and to amend and reenact sections two and two-b of said article, all relating to the excise tax on sale of cigarettes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section two-a, article seventeen, chapter eleven of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be repealed, and that sections two and two-b of said article be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 2. Purpose of Tax; Ratio.—For the purpose of 2 providing revenues for the general revenue fund of the

- 3 state an excise tax is hereby levied and imposed on sales
- 4 of cigarettes on and after midnight of the last day of
- 5 June, one thousand nine hundred sixty-six, at the rate
- 6 of one cent on each ten cigarettes or fractional part there-
- 7 of. Only one sale of the same article shall be used in com-
- 8 puting the amount of tax due hereunder.

Sec. 2-b. Additional Cigarette Tax for Support of

- 2 **Schools.**—For the purpose of providing additional revenue
- 3 for the support of free schools, there is hereby levied and
- 4 imposed, on and after midnight of the last day of June,
- 5 one thousand nine hundred sixty-six, in addition to the
- 6 tax imposed by section two of this article, an additional
- 7 excise tax of two cents on each ten cigarettes, or fractional
- 8 part thereof, sold within this state. Except as otherwise
- 9 provided in this section, all provisions of this article re-
- 10 lating to the levy, imposition and collection of the regular
- 11 excise tax on the sale of cigarettes shall be applicable to
- 12 the levy, imposition and collection of such additional tax.
- 13 Notwithstanding other provisions of this article to the
- 14 contrary, all moneys received from the additional tax
- 15 imposed by this section, less deductions allowed by this

- 16 article for refunds and for costs of administration and
- 17 operation, shall be paid by the tax commissioner into the
- 18 general school fund, to be used solely for the support of
- 19 free schools.
