House Bill No. 279

(By MR. SPEAKER, MR. WHITE, and MR. ARMISTEAD)

[Passed February 7, 1966; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section twelve, article three, chapter five-a of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to purchases of commodities and printing by the director of the purchasing division.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section twelve, article three, chapter five-a of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Article 3. Purchasing Division.

Section 12. Publication of Solicitation for Sealed Bids.

2 —The director shall solicit sealed bids for the purchase

3 of commodities and printing that is estimated to exceed
4 two thousand dollars. No spending unit shall issue a
5 series of requisitions which would circumvent this two
6 thousand dollar maximum. Bids shall be obtained by
7 public notice inserted at least twice in a newspaper
8 having a general circulation in the county where the
9 department or agency making the requisition is located
10 and in a daily newspaper of general circulation at least
11 two weeks before the final date of submitting bids and
12 by any other advertising medium the director may deem
13 advisable. The director may also solicit sealed bids by
14 sending requests by mail to prospective suppliers and by
15 posting notice on a bulletin board in his office: *Provided,*
16 *however,* That nothing contained in this article shall pre-
17 vent the director from purchasing commodities and
18 printing produced and offered for sale by nonprofit work-
19 shops, without the necessity of competitive bidding.
