AN ACT to amend and reenact section nine, article seven, chapter twenty of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to penalty for violations under subsection three, section five, article two of chapter twenty.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section nine, article seven, chapter twenty of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 7. LAW ENFORCEMENT, PROCEDURES AND PENAL-TIES.

§20-7-9. Violations of chapter generally; penalties.

1 Any person violating any of the provisions of this

2 chapter, or rules and regulations promulgated under

- the provisions of this chapter, the punishment for which is not prescribed, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and, upon conviction thereof, shall for each offense be fined not less than twenty nor more than three hundred dollars, or confined in jail not less than ten nor more than one hundred days, or be both fined and imprisoned within the limitations aforesaid; and, in the case of a violation by a corporation, every officer or agent thereof directing or engaging in such violation shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and, upon conviction thereof, shall be subject to the same penalties and punishment as herein provided:
