## ENROLLED Senate Bill No. 71

(By Mr. Moreland and Mr. McCourt)

[Passed March 10, 1967; in effect July 1, 1967.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section ten, article eleven, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to the general extension work conducted by the board of governors of West Virginia university, and to the disposition of fees collected by the board for the graduate level extension and graduate level off-campus courses it offers for credit.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section ten, article eleven, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

## ARTICLE 11. WEST VIRGINIA UNIVERSITY.

§18-11-10. General extension work of the university; disposition of fees charged for graduate level extension and off-campus courses.

The board of governors is hereby authorized and em-

- 2 powered to organize and conduct, through the organi-
- 3 zation of the different colleges, schools and departments
- 4 of the university, extension work and off-campus work
- 5 in the form of schools, classes, lectures, and other forms
- 6 of instruction, throughout the state.
- 7 Enrollment, tuition and other fees collected from stu-
- 8 dents enrolled in graduate level extension, and graduate
- 9 level off-campus, courses for credit taught off the campus
- 10 of the university, excluding educational television courses,
- 11 shall be paid into a special fund and be used for the pur-
- 12 pose of partially or fully covering the costs related to
- 13 the development and teaching of such graduate level
- 14 courses: Provided, That no portion of such fees commit-
- 15 ted to the retirement of any revenue bonds heretofore
- 16 issued pursuant to the provisions of articles eleven-a and
- 17 eleven-b of this chapter shall be paid into such special

- 18 fund for so long as any such bonds remain outstanding
- 19 and unpaid.
