

AN ACT to amend and reenact section six, article three, chapter twenty-four of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to the imposition, collection and disposition of special license fees payable by certain public utilities and manner of determination of such fees by the state auditor.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section six, article three, chapter twenty-four of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 3. DUTIES AND PRIVILEGES OF PUBLIC UTILITIES SUBJECT TO REGULATIONS OF COMMISSION.

§24-3-6. Special license fee; "public service commission fund".

(a) All public utilities subject to the provisions of , 1 2 this chapter shall pay a special license fee in addition to those now required by law. The amount of such fees 3 4 shall be fixed by the auditor and levied by him upon each of such public utilities according to the value of its 5 property as ascertained by the last assessment, and shall 6 be apportioned among such public utilities upon the 7 8 basis of such valuation, so as to produce a revenue of two hundred thousand dollars per annum, which fees shall 9 10 be paid on or before the twentieth day of January in each year. Such sum of two hundred thousand dollars, 11 12 together with that provided in subsection (b) hereof shall be paid into the state treasury and kept as a special fund, 13 designated "Public Service Commission Fund", to be 14 appropriated as provided by law for the purpose of 15 paying the salaries of the commission, as fixed by this 16 17 chapter, its expenses and salaries, compensations, costs 18 and expenses of its employees. e / 12 a

[Enr. Com. Sub. for S. B. No. 107 3 ः (b) All public utilities subject to the provisions of 19 this chapter shall pay a special license fee in addition 20 to any and all fees now required by law. The amount 21 of such fees shall be fixed by the auditor and levied 22 23 by him upon each of such public utilities, in the pro-24 portion which the total gross revenue derived from in-25 trastate business done by each of such public utilities 26 in the calendar year next preceding bears to the total gross revenue derived from intrastate business done in 27 such year by all public utilities subject to regulation by 28 29 the public service commission, so as to produce a revenue 30 of four hundred thousand dollars per annum, in addition 31 to such fees as may be fixed by the auditor under the 32 provisions of subsection (a) hereof and which fees shall 33 be paid on or before the first day of July in each year. Such sum of four hundred thousand dollars shall be 34 paid into the state treasury and be kept, appropriated 35 and used as provided in subsection (a) hereof. 36

37 (c) Any balance remaining in said fund at the end
38 of any fiscal year shall not revert to the treasury but
39 shall remain in said fund and may be appropriated and
40 used as provided in subsection (a) hereof.
