

## ENROLLED House Bill No. 226

(By MR. WATSON and MR. JONES, of Mason)

[Passed January 23, 1968; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section sixteen, article one, chapter three of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to election of state officers.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section sixteen, article one, chapter three of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS AND DEFINITIONS.

§3-1-16. Election of state officers.

1 At the general election to be held in the year one 2 thousand nine hundred sixty-eight, and in every fourth Enr. H. B. No. 226]

3 year thereafter, there shall be elected a governor, secre-4 tary of state, treasurer, auditor, attorney general, and commissioner of agriculture. At the general election in 5 6 the year one thousand nine hundred sixty-eight, and in every second year thereafter, there shall be elected a 7 8 member of the state Senate for each senatorial district, 9 and a member or members of the House of Delegates of 10 the state from each county or each delegate district. At the general election to be held in the year one thousand 11 nine hundred sixty-eight, and in every twelfth year there-12 after, there shall be elected one judge of the supreme 13 14 court of appeals, and at the general election to be held in the year one thousand nine hundred seventy-two, and 15 in every twelfth year thereafter, two judges of the 16 supreme court of appeals, and at the general election 17 to be held in the year one thousand nine hundred seventy-18 six, and in every twelfth year thereafter, two judges of 19 the supreme court of appeals. 20
