[Passed February 15, 1969; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section one-j, article two, chapter fifty-one of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to the terms of court for the tenth circuit.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section one-j, article two, chapter fifty-one of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 2. CIRCUIT COURTS; CIRCUIT, CRIMINAL AND INTER-MEDIATE JUDGES.

§51-2-1j. Tenth circuit.
