AN ACT to amend article thirteen-a, chapter thirty of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, designated section five-a, relating to the certification of underground surveyors and additional requirements therefor.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That article thirteen-a, chapter thirty of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section, designated section five-a, to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 13A. LAND SURVEYORS.**

§30-13-5a. Underground surveying; additional requirements.

1 After the first day of July one thousand nine hundred  
2 seventy, no person required to be licensed under the pro-  
3 visions of this article shall engage in underground sur-  
4 veying until he shall have first obtained a license under  
5 the provisions of this article and in addition shall have  
6 received from the board, after application therefor, a cer-  
7 tificate to engage in underground surveying, which cer-  
8 tificate shall remain valid so long and only so long as the  
9 license issues to such person under the provisions of this  
10 article remains unexpired, unsuspended and unrevoked.  
11 In order to be eligible for such certificate such person  
12 shall, in addition to the requirements for a license, have  
13 three years or more experience in the practice of under-  
14 ground surveying. In the event an application for any  
15 such certificate is denied, all of the provisions of sections  
16 nine and ten of this article shall be as fully applicable  
17 as if the application denied were an application for a  
18 license under the provisions of this article.
